Curriculum

Science: As scientists we will begin to look at landforms and waterways. Students will explore how water affects the erosion of landforms and ways plants reduce erosion.

Writing: We have just started a unit on opinion writing. Students will use what they know about character traits and other elements of reading to write about their favorite books. Students will focus on having a strong introduction, clear opinion statement, supporting evidence and an ending.

Math: We will be finishing up our unit on shapes, arrays and fractions. Our next unit focuses on different strategies to add and subtract double-digit numbers. Students will again solve story problems and be asked to show their math thinking.

Reading: We are continuing our study of character traits, determining important events and theme.
